It is important not to accept gifts, gifts or any other benefits (No Gift Policy) in order to survive.

According to the Organic Act on Prevention and Suppression of Corruption, B.E. 2020, Section 128, paragraph one, prohibits government officials from receiving property or other benefits under From whom may the money be calculated? In addition to assets or benefits that are appropriate according to laws, rules or regulations. issued by virtue of the provisions of the law Except for receiving property or any other benefits through ethics according to the principles and amounts specified by the NACC. and the Code of Ethics for Police Officials 2021, Section 2(2) Honesty Performing duties according to law Regulations of the Police Office National with transparency Do not show behavior that has implications for illegal exploitation. Goal 1, Section 1.1, for all government agencies to The unit announces that all government officials do not accept gifts and gifts of any kind while performing their duties (No Gift Policy).

Therefore, in order to prevent conflicts between personal interests and public interests (Conflict of Interest), accepting bribes, gifts, gifts, or any other benefits that affect the performance of duties, guidelines for anti-bribery have been established. (Anti-Bribery Policy) and not accepting

gifts, gratuities or any other benefits (No Gift Policy) from performing duties. The details are as follows:

Article 1 This announcement

"Commander" means a person who has the authority to command, supervise, monitor, and inspect police officers under his command.

"Bribe" means property or other benefits given to a person to induce that person. Act or not act in accordance with the position Whether it is right or wrong according to duty

"Performing duties" means an action or performance of duties by a government official in a position that has been appointed or assigned to perform duties under one duty. or to be acting on behalf of one of the duties, both general and specific, as a police officer whose powers and duties must be specified by law, or which is carried out in accordance with the powers and duties specified by law as having the powers and duties of the police.

"Gifts, presents, or any other benefits that affect the performance of duties" means money, property, services, or any other benefits that have value and include tips. Government officials receive in addition to money, warnings, income, benefits from government service in normal cases and affect decisions, approvals, permits, or anything else. In performing duties in a manner that is beneficial in a dishonest way to the gift giver in the past or while received or in the future

Article 2: Police officers at all levels shall conduct themselves as follows:

1. Do not ask for advice, do not give or accept bribes, gifts, gifts or any other benefits from Perform duties

2. Do not consent or connive with family members giving or receiving bribes, gifts, gifts or any other benefits to those involved in the performance of duties.

3. The performance of duties must be based on enforcing the law with fairness, taking advantage and the image of the police as important. Must not do anything that is a conflict between personal interests and public interests, such as accepting gifts. or any other benefits that affect the performance of duties, the use of government resources or national assets for personal gain, the disclosure of internal information, the use of official time to do extra work, in tons

4. Reduce the giving or receiving of property or other benefits under good ethics according to the criteria and amounts specified by the NACC Office by using the method of reporting. Express it by signing greeting cards, greeting books, condolence cards. or using social media instead

5. Do not tolerate, do not tolerate, or are indifferent to behavior from the performance of duties. If found to violate the law Let the Superintendent/Station Head know immediately.

Section 3 gives the commander the authority to supervise, monitor, and inspect police officers in Affiliates must conduct themselves in accordance with this announcement. In the case of discovering acts that violate this announcement, report them to the superintendent. The station/head of the station will respond quickly.

Section 4. Anyone who finds an action that violates this announcement can file a complaint/report information directly through the Superintendent at the Mae Ping Police Station. or via telephone number 28 3152 5633, which information Complaint/Whistle Informer will be concealed and kept strictly secret.

Section 5. In the case of receiving a complaint/clues Personnel under the supervision committed an offense at the police station. We will investigate the facts and if we find an offense, we will punish those who did it according to laws and regulations. and related regulations strictly and send matters according to the next command hierarchy

Therefore, it is announced for everyone to know and strictly observe.
